



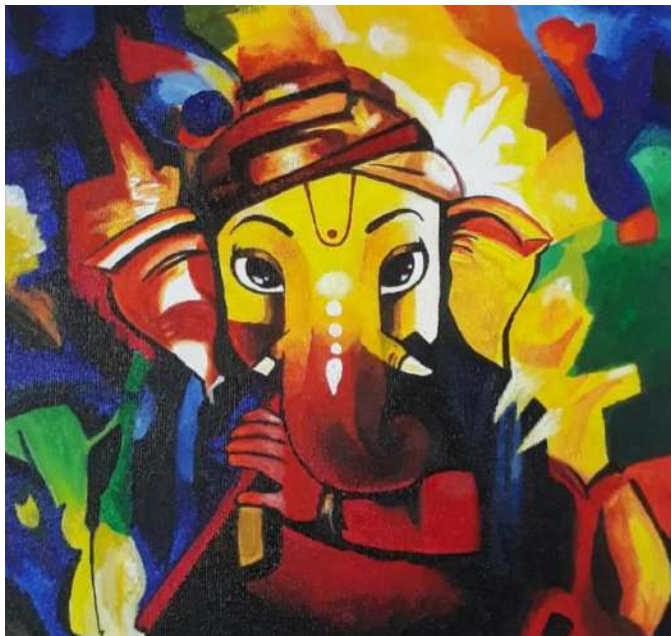

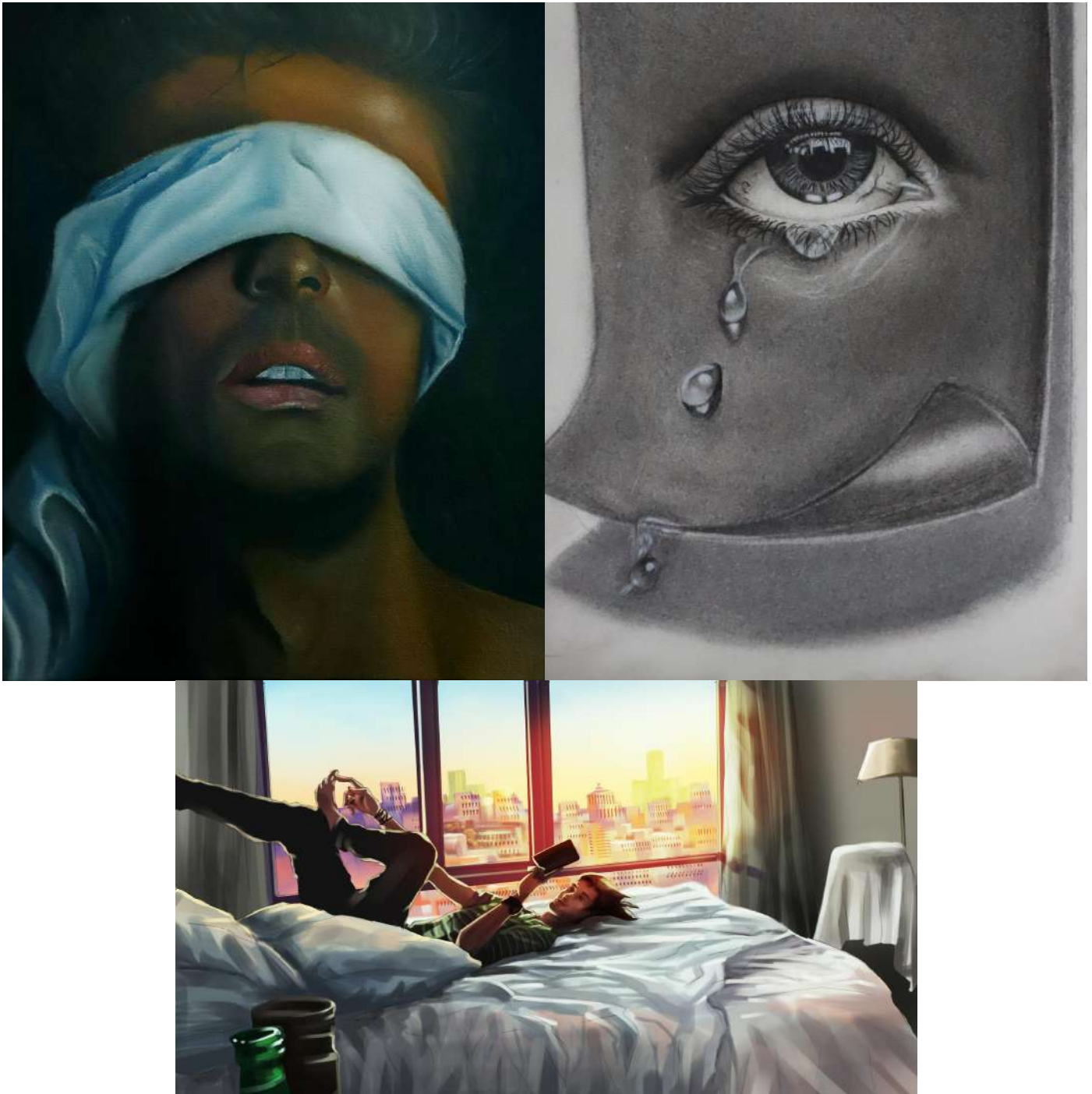
ABSTRACT

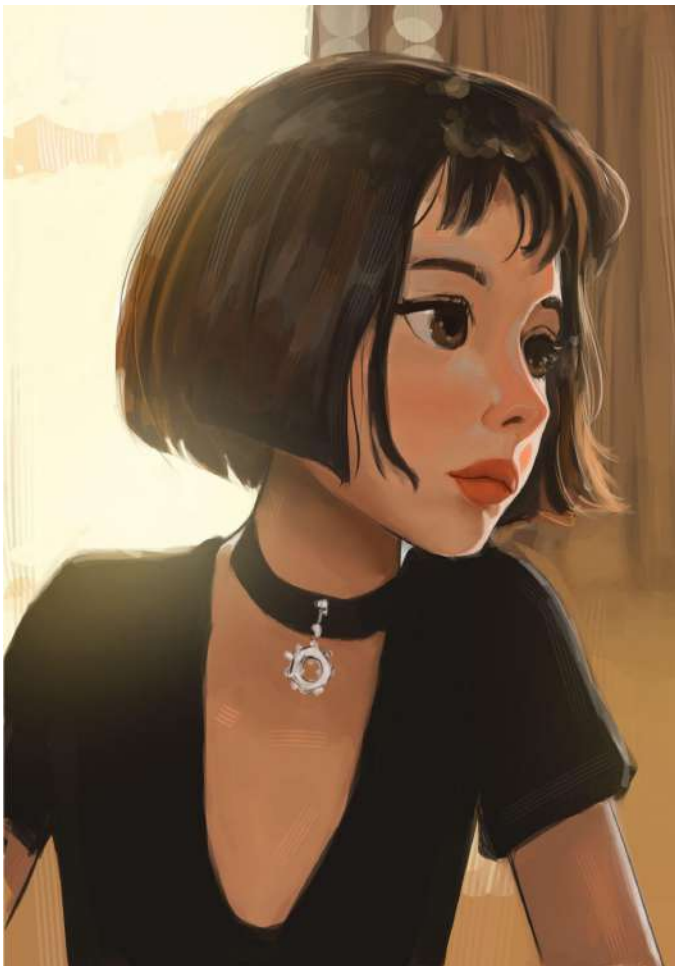

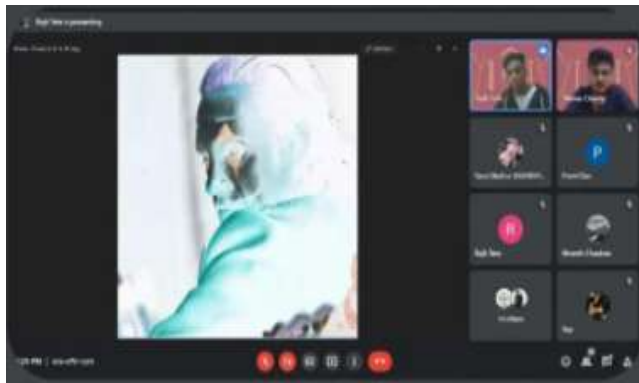

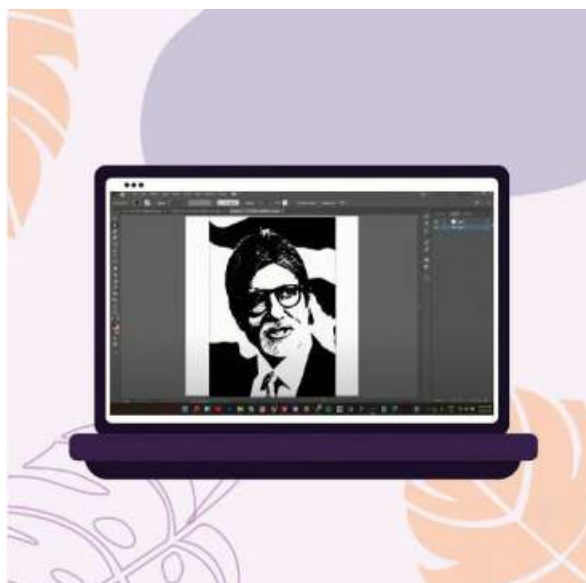
3. Video Editing Workshop (Jan '22)
